## DISTRICT OF FORT ST. JAMES ELECTIONS BYLAW NO. 1051, 2022

A Bylaw to provide for the determination of various procedures for the conduct of local government elections and other voting.

Under the Local Government Act, the Council may, by bylaw, determine various procedures and requirements to be applied in the conduct of local government elections and other voting.

Council wishes to establish various procedures and requirements under that authority.

The Council of the District of Fort St. James, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "District of Fort St. James Elections Bylaw No. 1051, 2022."
- 2. A person may register as an elector only at the time of voting for all elections and assent voting.
- 3. In addition to the required advance voting opportunity on the 10th day before general voting day, the 3<sup>rd</sup> day before general voting day shall be a second advanced voting day between the hours of 8:00 pm.
- 4. Advanced Voting Day and General Voting Day Voting locations shall be as established by the Chief Election Officer.
- 5. In the event of a tie vote after a judicial recount, the tie vote will be resolved by conducting a lot in accordance with section 151 of the Local Government Act.
- 6. The Chief Election Officer must give public access to nomination documents by posting on the District of Fort St. James website during the period from the time of delivery of the documents until 30 days after the declaration of election results.
- 7. The Chief Election Officer must give public access to elector organization endorsement documents by posting on the District of Fort St. James website during the period from the time of delivery of the documents until 30 days after the declaration of election results.
