

DISTRICT OF FORT ST. JAMES
TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATION BYLAW AMENDMENT
BYLAW NO. 970, 2017

A bylaw to amend “District of Fort St. James Traffic and Parking Regulation Bylaw No. 839, 2007.”

The Council of the District of Fort St. James enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as “Traffic and Parking Regulation Bylaw Amendment No. 3, Bylaw No. 970, 2017”.
2. “District of Fort St. James Traffic and Parking Regulation Bylaw No. 839, 2007” is amended as follows:

2.1 Subsections 2.35 through 2.37 are added following subsection 2.34:

2.35 **“Oversized Vehicle”** means a *Commercial Vehicle* having a *Gross Vehicle Weight* exceeding 20,000 kilograms or overall length exceeding 12.5 meters.

2.36 **“Provincial Highway”** means a *highway* owned and maintained by the Province of British Columbia.

2.37 **“Zoning Bylaw”** means the current Zoning Bylaw of the *District*, as amended.

2.2 Subsection 5.1(r) is added following subsection 5.1(q):

[Except when necessary to avoid conflict with *traffic* or to comply with the law or the directions of a *Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Police Officer, or traffic control device*, no person shall:]

- r) *Park an Oversized Vehicle* on any *Highway* within the *District*, except for a *Provincial Highway*, or if the *Highway* abuts a parcel designated as Commercial or Industrial under the *Zoning Bylaw*, unless the *Oversized Vehicle* is temporarily *Parked* and persons are engaged in the moving, loading, or unloading of furniture or other personal property of a resident within any residential zone.

2.3 Subsection 6.3 (e) is added following subsection 6.3 (d):

[Except as authorized by a written permit from the *Public Works Superintendent*, no person shall drive or operate on a *Highway*;

- e) a loaded *Oversized Vehicle* within the *District* except for a *Provincial Highway*, or if the *Highway* abuts a parcel designated as Commercial or Industrial under the *Zoning Bylaw*.
