## DISTRICT OF FORT ST. JAMES ANTI-IDLING BYLAW AMENDMENT NO. 1 BYLAW NO. 984, 2018

A bylaw to amend "District of Fort St. James Anti-Idling Bylaw No. 889, 2011."

The Council of the District of Fort St. James enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "Anti-Idling Bylaw Amendment No. 1, Bylaw No. 984, 2018."
- 2. "District of Fort St. James Anti-Idling Bylaw No. 889, 2011" is amended as follows:
  - 2.1 Sections 5(e) is deleted and replaced as follows:
    - 5. (e) motor vehicle that must remain idling to enable them to power any tools or equipment necessary for, or incidental to, providing emergency services, commercial services or public utility services;
- 3. If any part of this bylaw is held to be invalid by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed, without affecting the remainder of this bylaw.
