BYLAW NO. 985, 2018

A bylaw for the administration of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

The Council for the District of Fort St. James enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 985, 2018."
- 2. The Corporate Officer, or designate, of the District of Fort St. James is designated as the Head for the purposes of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, as amended.
- 3. The Schedule of Maximum Fees as established by British Columbia Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation, as amended, shall be the maximum fees charged by the District of Fort St. James for services under the Act.
- 4. "District of Fort St. James Freedom of Information Bylaw No. 601, 1995" is repealed.
