BYLAW NO. 743, 2001


A Bylaw to establish a reserve fund for Municipal Hall/Library Capital Works.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of Fort St. James in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. There shall be and is hereby established a reserve fund, under the provisions of section 496 of the Local Government Act, to be known as the "Municipal Hall/Library Capital Works Reserve Fund".
2. Money from current revenue, or as available, from general revenue surplus or as otherwise provided in the Local Government Act may be paid into the Reserve Fund.
3. The monies set aside shall be deposited in a bank account and, until required to be used, may be invested in the manner provided by the Local Government Act.
4. Monies in the Reserve Fund shall only be used for:
 - (a) Expenditures for, or in respect of, Municipal Hall/Library capital projects and land, necessary therefore.
5. This bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Hall/Library Capital Works Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 743, 2001".
