DISTRICT OF FORT ST. JAMES

BYLAW NO. 743, 2001

A Bylaw to establish a reserve fund for Municipal Hall/Library Capital Works.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Fort St. James in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- There shall be and is hereby established a reserve fund, under the provisions of section 496 of the <u>Local Government Act</u>, to be known as the "Municipal Hall/Library Capital Works Reserve Fund".
- Money from current revenue, or as available, from general revenue surplus or as
 otherwise provided in the <u>Local Government Act</u> may be paid into the Reserve
 Fund.
- The monies set aside shall be deposited in a bank account and, until required to be used, may be invested in the manner provided by the <u>Local Government Act</u>.
- Monies in the Reserve Fund shall only be used for:
 - (a) Expenditures for, or in respect of, Municipal Hall/Library capital projects and land, necessary therefore.
- 5. This bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Hall/Library Capital Works Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 743, 2001".
